WE NEED YOUR COOPERATION!

As Elderhaus has entered the post-COVID era of its history, we are taking a hard look at our policies and moving towards alignment with who we are and who we serve. In this process, it has come to our attention that we have some participants that do not have a regular & routine schedule. As our program attendance has grown, we can no longer allow participants to drop-in to the program at their or their caregivers convenience. It is critical to our staffing that participants commit to a schedule. We will continue to try to accommodate schedule changes or requests to add a day or so due to extenuating circumstances but we will begin requiring advance warning to do so. Additionally, participants that do not attend for a 30-day period, without advance notice, will be discharged.

Transportation is also a critical piece to our efficient operations. If you have set up transportation through Elderhaus, the expectation is that you will utilize the service as requested. Our transportation is a sought-after service and consequently often has a waiting list. If we see that there is a pattern of frequent call-offs, you will receive a notice of potential discharge from transportation if no improvement is seen.

We ask that you notify us by July 31st regarding your schedule so that we can enter August with a clear understanding of our census and can thus staff accordingly. 
