Code of CONDUCT

Elderhaus Adult Day Program, Inc. (Elderhaus/Mindset) promotes the general health, welfare and well-being of all our participants. Therefore, it is the practice of Elderhaus to enforce the following:

- No cellphone use while activities are going on. Cellphones need to be put away or left at home.
- No sharing of food with other participants.
- No profanity.
- No drugs or alcohol. Zero tolerance: Participant will be discharged from the program if they come to Elderhaus/Mindset under the influence of drugs/alcohol and/or are observed using alcohol or drugs while in our program.
- No bullying.
- No verbal or physical abuse of other participants or staff. Dependent on the severity and intention of the abuse, participant may be immediately terminated from the program.
- No destruction of property at Elderhaus or in the community.
- No stealing.
- No purchasing gifts for staff.
- No weapons (guns, knives, pepper spray, etc.), including toy weapons.
- No smoking/vaping except in designated area and with permission from staff. Only one person at a time in smoking area. No smoking/vaping on outings.
- No public displays of affection which includes but not limited to hugging, kissing, inappropriate touch, etc... Handshakes, high fives, and elbow hugs allowed.
- No sexual advances or inappropriate sexual comments.
- Maintain boundaries with staff: no calling staff or connecting via social media or email
- All medications must be checked in with staff unless you have been approved by the nurse to self-administer. This includes over-the-counter medications.
- Please always respect personal space and boundaries.

With the exception of our Zero Tolerance stand on drug/alcohol use, participants will first receive a verbal warning if observed violating any of the above, next violation will warrant a one to five day suspension, a third violation will result in immediate termination of services. Additionally, when a participant's actions create an unsafe situation for self, other participants, or staff, immediate termination may also be necessary.
